## **AIM SMALL & SCORE SMALL**

Golf strikes ultimately strive to find the bottom of a 4.25 inch round cylinder in the ground. It is appropriately called a 'Cup'. Then, carried one more precision refinement, your ball comes to rest in the 'Flag-Stick Pin Hole'. That is the size of a 'Quarter'. Pretty small targets!

So, what is there to lose by always striking your golf balls at 'Quarter Sized Target', whether it be mid fairway with 'The Big Stick' or a feathered little cut 'Bump & Run' with a short stick. If you accomplish these fantastical goals, your 'Flat Stick' can remain in the bag ... resting and looking very good at the end of 18! If you sink your 'Short Game Approach Shot' you have made "No Putts" ... never a bad thing!

A man or woman who makes few 'Putts' during a round has hit his or her 'Short Game Shots' in a tidy fashion! Never shy away from that 'Quarter Sized Target'. Relish in its allure!

Since we are talking about 'Small Targets' and adroitly placed 'Approach Shots', let me remind you that 'Your 555 Team' always 'Quadrants The Greens'. This enables us to 'Land & Stop' our balls on the right side of the hole ... below and slightly up hill are good traits ... better than slippery downhill sliders with breaks ... 'Heart Fibrilators'! ... 'Chokers'!

'Aim Small and Score Small'!
