SHORT GAME DRILLS

FOUR SPOT PUTTING

('Chipping')

We must 'Execute Our Putting & Chipping Strokes' 'Clubface AIMED', 'Clubhead On PATH' and 'Ball Contacting the Blade on the Sweet Spot or Centre of Mass' and with the right 'Clubhead Speed and Angle Of Attack'. If there is a 'Break' we must know all about it in order to programme our 'Ball Rolling Path or Line'. But 'ALL PUTTS & CHIPS ARE DEAD STRAIGHT'.

We 'Set-Up' '5 CONTROLS' with all the other 'Putting Procedural Check List Items'. You know them and if you do not, look in your 'Table of Contents' or 'Index' and seek them out.

Once we are 'SET-UP' and our 'Putting Axes' are 'ALIGNED' and our 'Neutral GRIP' is in place, we should have our 'TWO GRIP SPOTS' facing the Target.

So what are these 'TWO GRIP SPOTS'? (see 'Three Ink Spots')

The same type of 'SPOT' I used to mark your 'Golf Glove' for the 'One, Two or Three Knuckle GRIP', a 'Spot on your Target INDEX First Knuckle Joint' is used in this 'Putting Drill'. Put one on the back of your Target Hand for the Drill. With that 'Neutral GRIP' your 'Spot' will be AIMED or Pointing 'Down-The-Line' or in the Hole. You must keep it 'AIMING and PATHING' 'Down this line' at all times during the Putting Stroke.

The 'SECOND SPOT' is placed on the 'Back or Aft Heel' of the Brace Hand; the fatty portion closest to your crotch. Place the 'MARK or SPOT' on the skin that faces the Target. During your 'Neutral GRIPPED Stroke', make certain that this 'Spot' tracks 'Down the Line' along with the 'First Spot'.

The 'THIRD SPOT' is located on the outside of your 'Target Elbow' facing the 'Target'.

The 'FOURTH SPOT' is placed on the ground 'Inside The Rubber' and 'Target Eye Peripheral Vision' as your 'Ball Rolling Line Reference' ('BRL') just as you use in 'Spot Bowling'. This 'Four Spot' will be on the 'Target Line' is there is no break. If there is 'Break', the 'Four Spot' will be 'Displaced' or 'Off Set'. Remember that all 'Putts &

Chips Are Dead Straight'. All the 'BRL' curvature is created by 'Mother Nature' with her 'Slope, Up Hill and Down Hill and Side Hill' 'Out-Of-Levelness' of the green.

In this manner, you will be assured to maintain your 'Clubhead AIM and PATH' during the entire 'Putting Stroke'. This FEELING will help you to make a proper 'Rocking the Shoulders MOTION' as well. If you have 'Pre-Selected Components and Procedures' that utilize different aspects, making the 'Spot Track Down-The-Line to the Cup' is 'NEVER an ERROR'! You could argue that the best word is 'Seldom and Error' but, if you have this 'Two Spot Technique' actually becoming and 'Error', you might well assess your chosen technique.

In fairness, if your technique works nine times out of ten 'Strokes' from ten feet, wrong or not, do not change it. But you results must be 'High Percentage' to the 'Bottom of the Cup'. Poor 'Strokers of the Golf Ball on and around the Dance Floor' do not put low number on the card!

Be a great 'Putter & Chipper', like you can be. Just out of interest, I call this technique the 'Two Spot Insurance Putting'. You may choose to as well.
