That is all part of 'IT' right ... the ups and downs, the punishment golf so generously provides until we quit out of the 'Frustration Quotient' that runneth over the lip of a princely goblet? Regardless of our aspirations and prayers, we ALL get exposed to 'Chipping' with a touch of the 'Bump & Runs'. It is unavoidable. But we have not studied or practised these delicate shots. So they drag us kicking and screaming into 'Purgatory' ... then we quit!
