'SHORT GAME DRILLS'

THE HEADS OR TAILS DRILL

(One Thin Dime)

We have a tendency to 'Look Up Early' in the 'Putting & Chipping Through Stroke' to see the Ball go into the Cup. This contributes to it's not doing so. So, you avoid doing so as well!

Turning your 'EYES' turns your 'EARS' which turns your 'Head' and then your 'Shoulders' and then you cannot 'Putt and Chip'! Miss great 'SET-UP' and make 'Poor Ones By Mistake'!

A 'Practice Drill' is to place 'One Thin Dime' directly under your Ball. Prepare for and make your 'Putt'. After it leaves the 'Putter Face', 'Just Keep Watching the Dime'. Call it 'Heads or Tails'.

For real, 'Stroke Your Putt' and keep watching just one 'Blade of Grass' directly under the Ball.

This will tend to keep your 'Head Steady' as well.

When you are 'Steady' you will be able to make more consistent 'Strokes' be they 'Putting, Chipping, Bump & Run, Knock Downs, Pitches or Full Swing'. The 'Top Of The Tether Ball Pole' must not be swaying in the wind or bending.
