MANAGING YOUR SLICE

I have had the pleasure of working internationally with some of the 'World's Best Golf Teachers'. I spent a lot of time watching and listening! This was beneficial!

One very special person with whom I shared time and space was the unique and great 'World Golf Hall Of Famer' Moe 'Pipeline' Norman. He was one of the all time if not the best ever 'Ball Striker'. He is gone now but his legacy remains!

He told me a 'Golf Truth' better than two decades ago that is just as true and powerful today as it was then! Good information has longevity!

We were talking about 'The Hook and The Slice'.

Moe told me that, "The Ball Goes Where Your Hands Go"!

This is deservingly one of the five '555 Golf Primary Absolutes'.

This common 'Slice Malady' is about 'Clubhead and Hand PATH' as well as 'Clubface AIM At The Moment Of Separation'.

We went on to clarify this statement. Moe told me further that, "When a person 'Slices The Golf Ball', they are 'Cutting Across The Butt Of The Ball With The Clubface Employing An Outside-In Clubhead PATH' and generally with an 'Open Clubface AIM'. Thus the swinger imparts 'Side Spin Rate' in the direction or the 'Low Energy Side Of The Target Line'. This induces a 'Ball Flight Curvature Towards The Low Energy Side' as well.

If any person is 'Slicing Their Golf Ball Off The Tee Box', they can reduce, if not stop doing so by 'Swinging Their Hands Directly At The Target' or even a little 'In The Direction Of The 'Slice Curve'. This prevents the 'Outside-In PATH Error'. The 'Big Side Spin Cut Action' goes away and so too does the 'Slice'!
