One Minute Golf Tips 'WHERE PASSION MEETS PERFORMANCE'

THE THREE TARGETS

There are more than one! ... two more!

We have 1) 'The Far Target' which would be the 'Flagstick and Quarter' in a Par 3, for the stick on an 'Approach Shot' or a 'Quarter' for your 'Driver' even out there 335! Now that is demanding! But 'Aim Small, Hit Small'!

2) The 'Intermediate Target' is a huge advantage for anyone who wants to be accurate with any stick! It is a 'Point On The Ground' 10-15 inches in front of the Ball on the "Target Line' or 'Initial Ball Flight Line'.

3) The 'Ballistic Target' or what your '555 Team' refers to as the 'BIC' ('Bottom Inside Cheek') is where the 'Sweet Spot' of the clubface transfers energy to the 'Golf Ball'.

If any of these 'Targets' are off line or faulty, there is a price to pay!

But the 'Intermediate Target' is the sleeper! Very few people even give it the time of day!

Here is its central importance. If you can get the 'Sweet Spot Of The Square Clubhead' to pass through the center core of the ball and extend through the 'I/T', you shall be very happy!

Notice the word "THROUGH" and not "AT".

The 'I/T' invites 'Through-ness'.

Great gesture!
