PUTTING DRILLS

SLOPE & WIND

‘Putting’ is truly ‘Distance & Direction’, the easier of which is ‘Direction’. Most of us can get the ‘Blade Square To The Target Line’ although many struggle a little seeing the ‘Break’. I do as well at times when they are subtle. What frail beings we really are! We need to know the ‘Ball Rolling Line’ (‘Target Line Adjusted For Break’) and get the blade square to that line when we have break. Target offset data is key! Your ‘555 TEAM’ calls this the ‘Displaced Break’.

When we are in our ‘Putting Pre-Shot Routine’, make sure we do not skip or overlook the ‘Across The Line View’ which provides us the ‘Slope’ information we need for the process of collecting all the necessary data to be successful. We cannot guess our way into ‘Putting Success’!

When we know the ‘Slope’, we must also be aware of the prevailing and ‘Dance Floor Wind’ as it will affect our roll. Especially if the wind is blowing over a mound or byrn beside the green where it accelerates, one must factor the wind. How do we know when it is strong enough to matter? If it is flapping our pant legs and cuffs, it is strong enough to matter!
