PUTTING DRILLS

WATCH YOUR LANGUAGE

I never want to create 'Tension' or 'Pressure' by what I say or by what I am thinking. My 'Pre-Shot Routine' ('PSR') must fulfill one very core function. It must produce 'Confidence, Comfort and Consistency'.

I don't like talking or defining how a 'Putt' will roll by referring to 'How Much It Will Break'. You know what I mean ... "It is a right edge putt!" "It is three inches outside left edge!"

What this language means is that one expects the 'Putt' to move about three inches from left to right in order for the ball to enter the hole dead center. However, this '**Left Edge Rendition**' will be the last 'Image' in ones mind if we use it. Then the 'Image' and its shape becomes the 'Target', which can tend us to 'Push or Pull the Ball'. We ideally must fully understand that **'ALL PUTTS ARE DEAD STRAIGHT'!**

If we focus on the 'Edge', we often tend to putt right there, leaving the 'Putt On The Edge'. Remember to reinforce your 'Image' of the ball's going into the hole as the primary 'Image' even though the 'Ball Rolling Line' ('BRL') and the 'Ball Rolling Target' ('BRT') may be outside the hole.

I like to really 'Visualize The Actual Ball Rolling Line Into The Cup' and then to see it's rolling dead straight to my 'Displaced Target'. In that manner, I kill all the birds with as many stones as I require.

I want to 'Build Confidence, Comfort and Consistency' and not 'Confusion'!

Keep your 'Image Clear'!
