THE WEATHER-STRIPPING SWEET SPOT DRILL

(using two Long Irons as an 'C/H PATH Alley')

This is an 'Optimal Percussion Area' (OPA) Drill. We must remember that, of the five primary 'Putting Conditions', 1)'Clubface AIM', 2) 'Clubhead PATH', 3) Optimal Percussion Area', 4) 'Weight' or 'Clubhead SPEED' and 5) 'Angle Of Attack', it is scientifically known that the 'OPA' is the 'King Condition'!

Now it takes three clubs to make one Putt, two for the 'Lane' and one for Putting! (Four clubs soon enough) What is this Golf coming to anyway? Oh well, I have 14 Clubs in my bag. They all need the regular exercise.

'FEELING' the 'Target Line and Ball Rolling Line', which may utilize a 'Secondary Target' (inside the Rubber) is beneficial. If you do not it is a definite deficiency.

The most common shortcoming in Putting is 'Off-Centre **IMPACT**'. The second is poor 'Clubface **AIM**'. The third is this 'Misdirected **Clubhead Path**'.

The 'Most Damaging' of these three is the 'Off-Centre **IMPACT**' or the '**NON O.P.A.**' strike.

Place two one inch pieces of 'Weather-Stripping' vertically on the 'Face of your Putter' about 1.25 inches apart centered on the 'O.P.A.' and strike the Ball precisely between these When you are really good at this 'Drill' place the 'Weather-Strips' closer together.

Keep in mind that 'Distance' is a greater challenge in making the short stroke deliver than is 'Direction'.
